Meredith Preston McGhie is the Regional Director for Africa for the Centre for Humanitarian Dialogue. In addition to managing a range of open and confidential processes across the continent, Ms Preston McGhie currently helps to advise the parties in Somalia and Somaliland on potential political dialogue between them.

Previously, she has advised parties in the South Sudan conflict, the SPLM and NCP during the CPA implementation in Sudan, in 2008 acted as an advisor to H.E. Kofi Annan in the Kenya National Dialogue and Reconciliation and in 2009 advised the UN in the Djibouti Peace Process for Somalia.

Ms Preston McGhie also focuses on issues of inclusion in mediation and elections and mediation for the HD Centre. She has been based in East and the Horn of Africa for 18 years, and previously worked with the UN in Sudan. Ms Preston McGhie began her career working with the Naga in Northeast India and with ethnic minorities in Myanmar.
