Philipp Lustenberger is the co-head of the swisspeace Mediation program. He focuses on mediation process design, national dialogue and inclusivity/participation.

He holds a Master's degree from the School of Advanced International Studies (SAIS) at Johns Hopkins University and a license from the Graduate Institute of International and Development Studies in Geneva.

Before his current role, he worked as Senior Advisor for the Colombian Peace Process at the Embassy of Switzerland in Bogota (Colombia), accompanying the peace talks and supporting peacebuilding activities. Previously, he worked at the Mediation Support Unit of the UN Department of Political Affairs in New York, where he was involved in drafting the UN Guidance for Effective Mediation and providing technical support for mediation and negotiation processes in Africa and Latin America. He has also worked on humanitarian and peacebuilding projects in Guatemala, India, the Philippines and Sudan.

He is a trained mediator and has published on ripeness theory and inclusivity.
